




In our old school building, Bill was introduced to one of our classes. Then we toured construction of the new six classrooms.

Seven years ago, Godfrey burnt a tree down which had been used by witchdoctors for years. The same day he became insane, became a drunkard and he burnt down his own family's home. On the day we drove to the building site, Godfrey along with some other laborers had already constructed most of the wooden framework laced with 1" to 2" saplings. When we returned from our trip to Mailisaba, we went to see the matope (mud) work that had been done to the structure.

As you can see from the pictures, it was a glorious and thanks filled day. The funds we had allotted were already finished, but Bill decided to purchase doors and windows! He flew out on the 23rd and did not get to see the finished work.



Prayer Request: \$5,800 is needed to complete our six classroom structure and prepare each classroom with a teacher desk and student table-benches. The Kenyan government is requiring that we have all construction completed and everything in place before January 23rd 2023.
