### **A Testimony of God's faithfulness**



Sally Minayo is a lady who has learned to trust in the Lord. She has five siblings, and as a very young girl her parents would take her to Sunday school where she began to learn about the God of the Bible.

At the age of eight her mother passed away. This was a big challenge because having a mother is very crucial. Four years later her father passed away. That was a very big blow to her and her siblings.

When their parents were alive, they lived in Nairobi. But after their death, they were moved to the country side to live with their grandmother. Sally's grandmother was very prayerful and instilled in her good morals. She also loved and cared for them.

Years later, while Sally was in Form Three (Junior), her grandmother also passed away. She nearly fell into depression. She loved her grandmother so very much and was the only parent remaining. She struggled a lot in school because there was no money for many normal needs. And sometimes no money for school fees, so attendance was delayed.

Although she didn't know about God very well, she believed that one day God would make a way. One year later, God made a way to join the University. It was then that she accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her personal savior. She later joined Full Life Ministry Kenya which became her family. Through her dedication and Discipleship Training, she has become strong in the Lord. She has married and has one beautiful little daughter. *Mungu ni mwaminifu! (God is faithful!)*

### **God's protection and rescue**

Now that he is home with his family, I can share some details which has had many of us praying for the last 8 weeks. One of our pastors went missing and as the days and weeks without any communication continued, we had only our God to run to.

In April, Pastor Mustafa traveled to Mombasa to transport his very ill Muslim mother back to her married homeplace. All the extended family, Muslims, including the husband refused shelter and demanded them to leave. Then after many challenges he was able to secure her at her (birth) homeplace.

It was after that the details are still not clear or complete. We do know he then travel alone to Kitale to try to negotiate bus transport back home because of lack of enough fare. He remembers sitting in a crowded staggering area and as he recollects a sharp pain in the head & back. Four weeks later, his next memory is finding himself in a hospital bed 6 hours driving time from Kitale.

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From what we were able to piece together, truly it is a miracle he is alive. He does also remember walking and walking on hot sand. That is consistent with the landscape of Turkana County north of Kitale and his feet still have many cuts.

When we found him, the doctor shared what information she could, starting with how he arrived at the hospital. A good Samaritan (the description she used) “dropped him at the entrance of the hospital and ran away.” In Kenya, you usually are not admitted without money. That’s where things are not yet clear but, we have a paid receipt and the doctor told us an old man & his wife paid for him.

We also were told that couple (who are surviving by selling water they carry into the village) tried to nurse him without much success at their home. That effort defiantly contributed to the blessing, we found him and he is still alive.

We thank our God that Pastor Mustafa was returned to his wife and children. It was necessary to transport him back into the hospital last Friday for some serious testing which is to be done today, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. He has a sizable memory loss, has lost a lot of weight and has some internal problems. I share his condition asking that you seriously continue to pray for him...and his family.

I am so grateful for those of you who have been fasting and praying. Ndiyo, Mungu ni mwaminifu!  
[Yes, God is faithful!]
